ITEM NO. I: Change of name of the College.

In the memorandum of Association and Rules relating to the establishment of the College, the name of the college has been given as under:

"College of Engineering and Technology, Gurdaspur".

The Board of Governors in its 1st meeting held on 7.3.94, while considering Item No.9, regarding change in the name of the College resolved that the name of the College be changed to:

"Beant College of Engineering and Technology, Gurdaspur".

In view of the above, the Society may consider changing the name of the College, wherever occurring in the Memorandum of Association and the Rules as under:

"Beant College of Engineering and Technology, Gurdaspur".

The State Government has also approved the change of the name of the College as proposed above.

"11-C. Cognizance of offences.—No prosecution for an offence under Section 11-A shall be instituted, except by or with the sanction of the Registrar, and no prosecution for an offence under Section 11-B shall be instituted except by or with the consent of the State Government."—Maharashtra Act 11 of 1968.

**12. Societies enabled to alter, extend or abridge their purposes.**—Whenever it shall appear to the governing body of any society registered under this Act, which has been established for any particular purpose or purposes, that it is advisable to alter, extend, or abridge such purpose to or for other purposes within the meaning of this Act, or to amalgamate such society either wholly or partially with any other society, such governing body may submit the proposition to the members of the society in a written or printed report, and may convene a special meeting for the consideration thereof according to the regulations of the society;

But no such proposition shall be carried into effect unless such report shall have been delivered or sent by post to every member of the society ten days previous to the special meeting convened by the governing body for the consideration thereof, nor unless such proposition shall have been agreed to by the votes of three-fifths of the members delivered in person or by proxy, and confirmed by the votes of three-fifths of the members present at a second special meeting convened by the governing body at an interval of one month after the former meeting.

**1. State Amendments.**—The amendments made by amending Acts in certain States are given below:

**GUJARAT**

Same as that of Maharashtra.

**MAHARASHTRA**

In Section 12 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (XXI of 1860), after the words 'other society' the words 'or whenever the governing body of any society registered under this Act decides to change the name of the society' shall be inserted—Bombay Act 53 of 1948, S. 2.

"Pending proceedings and construction of references to Registrar of Companies instruments issued or made before this Act.—(1) All proceedings under the said Act pending before the Registrar of Companies at the date of commencement of this Act shall stand transferred to the Registrar of Societies and any such proceeding shall be continued and disposed of by

which any other existing society has been registered or in the opinion of the Registrar so nearly resembles the name of such other society as is likely to deceive the public or the members of either society, the Registrar shall refuse to register the change of name.

(2) Save as provided in sub-section (1), the Registrar shall, if he is satisfied that the provisions of this Act in respect of the change of name have been complied with, register the change of name and issue a certificate of registration altered to meet the circumstances of the case. On the issue of such certificate the change of name shall be complete.

(3) The Registrar shall charge for any copy of a certificate issued under sub-section (2) a fee of rupee one and all fee so paid shall be accounted for to the State Government."—Orissa Act No. 8 of 1969.

PONDICHERRY

"12-A. Change of name.—Any number not less than three-fifths of the members of any society registered under Section 3 may, subject to the provisions of Section 12-B, a resolution or otherwise change its name."—Pondicherry Act IX of 1969, Section 5 (1-1-1970).

PUNJAB, HARYANA AND CHANDIGARH

"12-A. Registration of change of name.—(1) Where a proposition for change of name has agreed to and confirmed in the manner prescribed by Section 12, a copy of the proposition so agreed to and confirmed shall be forwarded to the Registrar of Companies for registering the change of name. If the proposed name is identical with that by which any other existing society has been registered, or in the opinion of the Registrar so nearly resembles such name as to be likely to deceive the public or the members of either society, the Registrar shall refuse to register the change of name.

(2) Save as provided in sub-section (1), the Registrar shall, if he is satisfied that the provisions of this Act in respect of change of name have been complied with, register the change of name and issue a certificate of registration altered to meet the circumstances of the case. On the issue of such a certificate the change of name shall be complete.

(3) The Registrar shall charge for any copy of a certificate issued under sub-section (1) a fee of rupee one and all fees so paid shall be accounted for to the State Government."—Section 3 of Punjab Act No. VI of 1949, Act XXXI of 1966.

UTTAR PRADESH

"12-A. Change of name.—Any society registered under this Act may, with the consent of not less than two-thirds of the total number of its members", [and with the previous approval of the Registrar in writing change its name by resolution passed at a general meeting convened for the purpose."—Section 6 of U. P. Act No. LII of 1975.

Section 12-B

ASSAM

"12-B. Notice of change of name.—(1) Notice in writing of every change of name, signed by the Secretary and by seven members of the society changing its name, shall be sent to the Registrar.
