| | <p>It is submitted that in the memorandum of Association (MOA) and rules relating to the establishment of the College, the name of the College has been given titled as College of Engineering and Technology, Gurdaspur and was registered under societies registration act XXI of 1860 with the issuance of Certificate bearing no.1146 of 1993-94 issued by Registrar of Firms & Societies, Punjab, Chandigarh.</p> <p>The Board of Governors in its 1st meeting held on 7.3.94, while considering item no.9, regarding change in the name of the College resolved that the name of the College be changed to "Beant College of Engineering and Technology, Gurdaspur" (Copy of minutes of meeting of 1st BOG is placed as Annexure - III, Pages 3-7). The Society further ratified the change in the name of the college as per the proposal of the state Government as agenda item no. 01 vide memo no. 1689-94 / P&D Dated 27.04.1994 and resolved for the said change in the Memorandum of Association and the Rules, wherever occurring (Copy of minutes of meeting of 1st Society is placed as Annexure - IV, Pages 8 - 10).. The said amendment had also been done by the office of Registrar of Firms and Societies, Punjab (copy of certificate no.1146/1993-94/14 Dated 03.1.1996 is attached herewith as Annexure - V, Pages 11 - 13)</p> <p>It is submitted that the said change in Memorandum of Association and Rules could not be affected (Copy of Memorandum of Association and Rules is placed as Annexure - VI, Pages 14 - 29).</p> <p>It is further informed that the Govt of Punjab, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training accorded approval to start 10+2 (Science Group) and three years Diploma course (with three streams CE,ECE, ME) in the existing campus of this institute</p> |

under the NABARD Project as per notification no.13/03/09-1TE2/481 dated 12.02.2009 (**Copy of notification is placed as Annexure - VII, Pages 30**). Accordingly, Diploma courses have been started in the campus of Beant College of Engineering & Technology, Gurdaspur after getting approval from AICTE, New Delhi and Affiliated to PSBTE & IT Punjab, Chandigarh. Further, 10+1 and 10+2 non-medical classes has been started in the **Beant College of Engineering and Technology, Gurdaspur** Gurdaspur and the same has been affiliated with Punjab School Education Board, Mohali and the fee structure is being charged as applicable to Govt. School (**Copies of the affiliation orders of PSBTE, Chandigarh and PSEB, Mohali are placed at Annexure - VIII, Pages 31-32**).

Now the college has filed the case in the office of Commissioner (Exemption) of Income Tax Department, Chandigarh for the registration of college under 12AA of Income Tax Act,1961. On the filing of said application for the registration of college under Income Tax Act 1961, The Deputy Commissioner (Exemption), Income Tax (HQ), Chandigarh has issued a show cause notice The reply of show cause notice has been submitted & The Commissioner of Income Tax has issued the final orders vide their letter no. I.T.(E)/Chd./12A/2016-17/5200 dated 30.09.2016 and rejected the income tax exemption case on the reasons mentioned at sr. no. 11 & 12 of the said order (**Copy of the letter is placed at Annexure - IX, Pages 33-38**). The said order suggested for the change of the name of the college from College of Engineering & Technology Society, Gurdaspur to **Beant College of Engineering & Technology, Gurdaspur** and incorporation **Beant College of Engineering and Technology, Gurdaspur (+2 Science Group)** in the Memorandum of Association, Rules and Bye-Laws.

The copy of the Memorandum of Association (MOA) and Rules is placed at Annexure - VI, Pages 14 - 29. It is submitted that the said changes in the highlighted and underlined text of the Memorandum

of Association (MOA) and Rules be allowed.

So it is submitted that approval may kindly be given for the change in the name of the college from College of Engineering & Technology Society, Gurdaspur to **Beant College of Engineering & Technology, Gurdaspur** in the Memorandum of Association and Rules wherever occurs.

| | <p>This College was established by Govt. of Punjab in the year 1995 to give an impetus to the Industrial Scenario of the Border District of Gurdaspur. This college is registered under Societies Registration Act of 1860. The affairs of the college are administered through its Board of Governors (BOG), a body which is constituted as per AICTE norms. The institute is having approximately 70 acres of land and is known for its lush green state of the art campus.</p> <p><u>Intake</u></p> <p>The total intake the students has increased many fold in the recent years. Presently, the institute is running 7 UG programs (Civil, Computer Science, Mechanical, Information Tech., Chemical, Biotech, Electronics and Communication Engineering) with total intake of 784 students, 3 PG programs (Thermal Engineering, Physics and Chemistry) with initial intake of 78 students. Besides, 3 diploma courses (Computer, Mechanical, Electronics) and 10+1, 10+2 (science group) to cater the needs of the nearby rural students.</p> <p><u>Awards and Recognitions</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Indian Association for the Blind has awarded “ Silver Zone” for outstanding excellence and amazing commitment towards voluntary contribution for the empowerment of persons with visual challenges in 2015. • The Institute was placed among top 100 Engineering Colleges in India by EDURAND- a global research organization for ranking of All India Engineering Colleges in the year 2014. • Engineering wing of the Institute has been awarded “Best Faculty Institute in Punjab” by “CMAI National Punjab Education Awards 2013” presented by Hon’ble Madan Mohan Mittal Cabinet Minister for Technical Education and Industrial Training Punjab in 2013. • The Institute was given “Award of Honour” by Indian Red Cross Society (Punjab) in 2009 for rendering commendable services in organizing blood donation camps. |

Accreditation and Academic Autonomy

- Three B.Tech programs of the Institute were accredited by National Board of accreditation in the year 2009 for three years and institute achieved milestone- being the only Government Engineering College of Punjab affiliated to Punjab Technical University which got accreditation in N.B.A.
- The UGC New Delhi granted academic autonomous status in the year 2013 for six years. Now the institute is competent to conduct Examinations with its own Board of Examinations. The curriculum is designed as per the latest needs and trends of the Industry and thereby giving better employability to the budding Engineers.
- The three programs in the Institute have been re accredited and two more programs got accreditations in the year 2016 by NBA. This marks another major achievement of the Institute in the region.
- The institute has also been accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2016 for five years, which is another milestone achieved by the institute.

Grants Received under Sponsored Projects

- The Institute was awarded a grant of Rs. 10.0 Crore under Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme. The Institute is leading institute among all other Engineering Colleges of India for procuring the equipment under TEQIP scheme.
- A project for installation of solar energy plant of 50.0 KVA was submitted to the Ministry of Renewable Energy Resources and the same was accepted by the said department. The college received Rs. 50.0 Lacs grant for the installation of the solar panels in the college campus. This project was completed in 2013 with an expenditure of Rs. 65.0 Lacs. The electric power produced is being fed to the College Power House for further distribution in the college campus.
- The Institute has got Rs. 2.0 Crore from AICTE for the construction of Girls Hostel for SC/ST students under Babu Jagjiwan Ram Scheme of Govt. of India.
- The AICTE New Delhi has granted and funded various projects under MODROB (about 1.0 crore), TAPTEC (5.0 lacs), R&D (9.0 lacs), as well as RPS (6.45 lacs) during the last few years.

Infrastructure Development

- An administrative block and chemical engineering block were constructed in 2006 at a cost of Rs. 1.0 crore and a boys hostel with an expenditure of about Rs. 1.5 crore was constructed. These building were inaugurated by then Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of Punjab on 14.02.2006.
- In year 2006, the construction of the boundary wall of the college was completed with an expenditure of about Rs. 61.0 lacs.
- The re-carpeting of already existing roads and the construction of additional roads in the college campus was done in the financial year 2006-07 at an expenditure of Rs. 30.0 lacs.
- Keeping in view the need and demand of students, faculty and staff, construction of college canteen was done in 2007 with an approximate expenditure of Rs. 75.0 lacs.
- The modernization of the laboratories and class rooms was taken up in the year 2008-09 and an expenditure of Rs. 60.0 lacs was made for the construction of 4 new class rooms in the mechanical block in addition to the renovation of the labs in computer science and mechanical engineering department.
- The construction of 12 type-II and 24 type-III houses was taken up in the year 2009 to accommodate the newly recruited faculty/staff members.
- The construction of an auditorium in the college campus was initiated in the year 2009 at an estimated cost of Rs. 6.0 crore. A part of the auditorium complex has been completed in the year 2014 and is being utilized for the central library and for some of PG classes.
- The college utilized NABARD ASSISTANCE PROJECT in 2009 for the construction of its polytechnic wing at an estimated cost of Rs 5.0 crores.
- Due to widening of National Highway along the gate of college campus, the old Entrance Gate was demolished. Therefore, construction of new gate along with the check post and approach road was done in 2015 with the funds received from the NHAI.
- The college spent Rs. 13 lacs in 2016 for the construction of new tube well /bore to provide the safe drinking water to the students, staff and other residents of the college.
- To keep in pace with the Digital India campaign, the college established

QEEE Class room by installing the required infrastructure in one of the classroom in 2013.

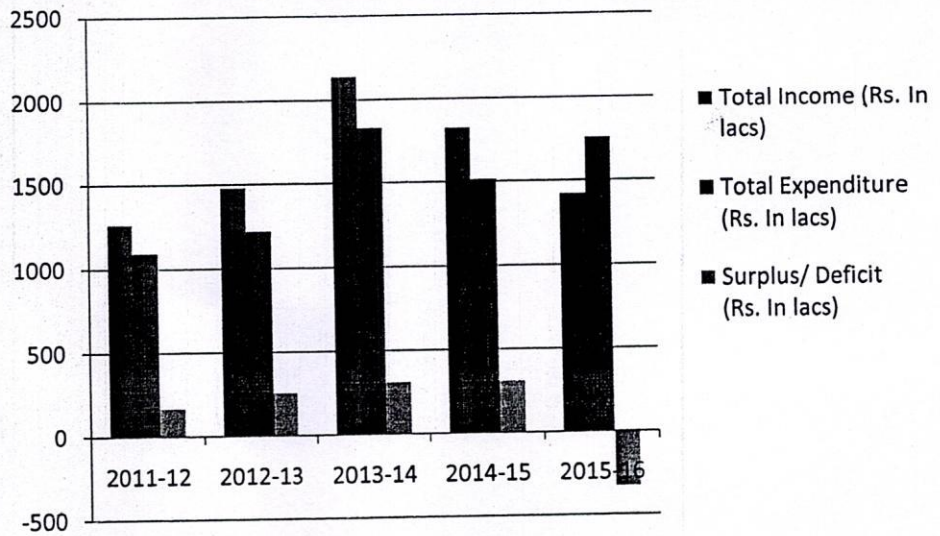
- The college has initiated the process to install Sewage Treatment Plant of capacity 300 KLD in the campus at an estimated cost of Rs. 70.0 lacs and the work has already been awarded to Water Supply and sanitation Division, Gurdaspur.

Year-wise Financial Position of the Institute

The college was promoted and established by Govt of Punjab in the year 1995 with an initial grant of Rs. 36.0 crore. The college has grown and progressed as a self financing institute and the financial position for the last five years is depicted below:-

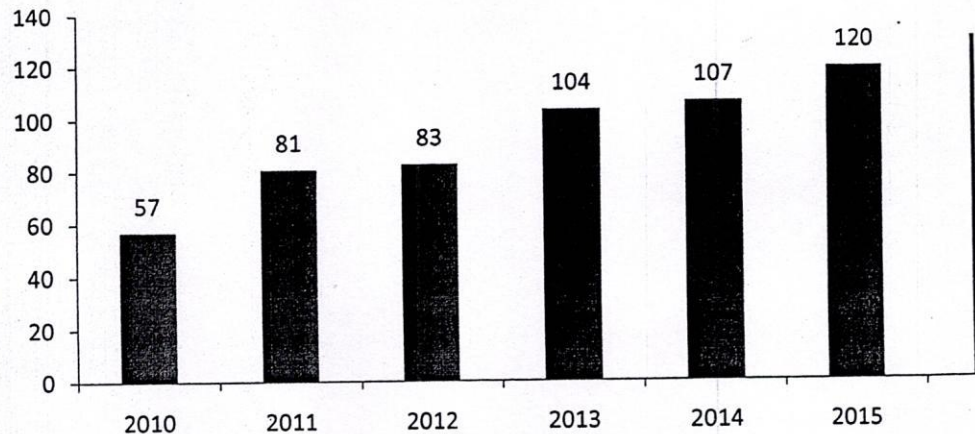

Annual Technical and Non Technical Activities

1. We organize "Expert Lectures" delivered by Academicians / Industry persons / Alumni for undergraduate students during each semester. Besides, college provides funding to students for "Innovative Projects". Pedagogical contents under "Quality Enhancement in Engineering Education (QEEE)" are also being delivered to our students during each semester.
2. Every year Department of mechanical engineering organize 2 day National conference on "Recent Trends in Mechanical Engineering". Department also organized one week short term course on "Recent Trends in Engineering" and "Advances in Mechanical Engineering" respectively in year 2013 and 2014. Besides, two workshops on "Intellectual Property Rights(IPR)" and "CAD/CAM" were also organized in 2013. Recently in year 2015, Mechanical Engineering Department organized faculty development program on "New and Renewable Energy Technologies". Department also organized a short term course on "Computer Aided Engineering" in collaboration with NITTR in year 2010.
3. Recently, one day workshop on "NAAC Accreditation for Affiliated /Autonomous Colleges" was organized during February 2016.
4. College successfully organized a short term course on "GIS and Remote Sensing Application in Engineering" in collaboration with NITTR

Chandigarh in year 2011.

5. **Department of Applied Sciences** organized the very first short term course on "**Recent Trends in Mathematics**" in year 2004 followed by 2- day National Conference on "**Recent Advancements in Mathematics**" in year 2014. Besides, department also organized workshop on "**Awareness Program on Nuclear Technology**" in collaboration with BARC Mumbai and Department of Atomic Energy in year 2014. A one week faculty development program on "**Nano Science & Technology**" was also organized in collaboration with PITTTR in year 2015.
6. Department of Information Technology in collaboration with NITTTR organized a one week short term course on "**Effective Curriculum Implementation**" in year 2015.
7. Department of Computer Science & Engineering organized a short term course on "**Cloud Computing**" in year 2014 along with workshop on "**IT Security & Ethical Hacking**".
8. Every year, we organize **Annual Convocation and Alumni Meet**.
9. NSS organizes (once or twice every year) "**Blood Donation Camp**" in collaboration with Red Cross Society of India. NSS also organize an event on "**Tree Plantation**" to keep the campus lush green.
10. "**Induction Program**" is being held every year at the start of academic session for newly admitted students where they get acquainted with the college faculty/staff members and infrastructure facilities.
11. Annual cultural festival "**Sui-Generis**" is being organized every year along with "**Annual Athletic Meet**".
12. Two day technical festival under the banner of ISTE is being held every year where students present their creativities/skills/innovations in the form of engineering models, debates, technical presentation etc.
13. College also encourage the faculty members to present their research contribution at National/International conferences where they get interacted with researchers which provide them an exceptional opportunity to learn and exchange leading-edge knowledge and experience.
