Beside the above the following decisions have also been taken:

- All DMCs will be evaluated.
- M.Phil = 05 marks, Ph.D = 10 marks (subject to maximum 10 marks).
- (a) The Peer Review Journal/Publication marks will be calculated as per the impact factor of the Publication such as: Impact factor 02 will carry 02 marks for publication *and so on*  
 Impact factor 01 will carry 01 mark for publication.  
 (b) Paper presented in conferences/workshops/symposiums/Seminar will carry 05 mark for presented paper, (subject to maximum 10).
- 01 mark will be given per year experience. If the candidate has experience less then one year i.e. for few months, then the total number of months will be calculated and divided by 12 to get the years to evaluate the marks for the experience, (subject to maximum 05).


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- 5. Test will carry 120 multiple choice questions for 2 hours duration. Each correct answer will carry 01 mark and wrong answer will carry -0.5 marks (negative marking).
- 6. Interview will have two components.
  - (a) Short Presentation will carry 05 marks.
  - (b) Subject domain knowledge will carry 10 marks.


